in reference to the DS-RPC Owners Manual

### DS4D-RPC

The DS4D-RPC main unit provides a dual-host capability, giving the user either out-of-band dial-up or inband TELNET remote access to the unit and attached equipment.

This unit typically utilizes a DS71-MD3, coupled with a DS72 Ethernet module. This setup allows the user to dial-in to the main unit and access the DS74 serial module(s). By using the DS72 Ethernet module, the user can access the DS74 serial module(s) via the network.

The bus can only be accessed by one host module at a time. If the bus is currently in use, the second host will prompt the user that the bus is in use by another operator. There is also a prompt asking if the user would like to terminate the other session. If answered "Yes", the first connection will be terminated and the second connection will be made. Either user can initiate this action.

**IMPORTANT:** There is no hierarchy for this function. Since either user may disconnect the other user, caution should be exercised.

### DS71- MD3

The DS71-MD3 operates the same as the DS71-MD2 at a speed of 33.6 Kbps.
